WHO CAN ENTER FOR THE LAIF AWARDS 2024

1. The LAIF Awards is open to ALL members of the AAAN.
2. Non-AAAN members outside of Nigeria, in equivalent sector association across West Africa, are allowed to enter
3. Under sectoral MOU's, non-AAAN members such as MIPAN and OOAN are allowed to enter within specific categories
4. Work created for the Nigerian and West African market is eligible for entry
5. The LAIF Awards 2024 is open to all areas of Brand Communication – including but not limited to Advertising, PR, Design, Architecture & Interior Design, Live Events & Activations, Sponsorships, Digital Media and Social Media – and any other areas where a brand interacts with consumers.
6. All work must be created, published or produced by the submitting entity
7. All submissions must have a brand association, except where the category rules apply
8. In the case of multiple agencies working on a particular project/campaign, all parties must agree on the agency to put in the entry and must have agreed on how the credits will be recognized. Any duplicated entry from another agency with same entry will be cancelled. No refunds will be granted on multiple entries.
9. All student work, created and submitted to a registered educational institution from the Eligible agency, may be entered. Unless permission is granted by the LAIF Awards in writing, student work should be submitted by the School/ College/ University, rather than directly by the individual student.

- Works conceptualised and produced by a Nigerian agency for the Nigerian, West African or global market

WEST AFRICAN

- Works conceptualised and produced by a West African agency for the Nigerian, West African or global market

GLOBAL PARTNERSHIP

- Works conceptualised, conceptually adapted, or produced by a Nigerian or West African Agency in partnership with a global agency for the Nigerian, West African or global market market

** Note: Nigerian or West African non-conceptual adaptations, translations, edits or reproduction of work by a global agency for the Nigerian, West African or global market CANNOT enter.*

HOW TO ENTER FOR THE LAIF AWARDS 2024

- Choose which work(s) you would love to enter
- Visit www.laif.com.ng/entry
- Choose the appropriate category
- Fill the entry form as required
- Upload the work
- Check that all mandatory fields are completed
- Upload all proof of deployment documents (e.g. certificate of transmission, tear sheets, screengrabs etc)
- Upload a summary of the Client's brief
- Upload any additional entry support documents
- You can upload same entry to as many categories/subcategories as you deem fit (Consult the categories section)
- Go to check out and make payment

NB

- All entries must have run or been exposed in media visible to Nigerian / West African consumers.
- Copyright ownership of the entry must rest in the organisation entering the work
- Entries are only valid AFTER payment has been confirmed.
- All entries must be submitted on or before the Entry Close Date.
- All entries must have been run/exposed between 1st June 2023 and 30th July 2024.

THE LAIF AWARDS 2024 ENTRY FORMATS

DOCUMENTS

- All text based documents must be submitted in PDF. This includes supporting documents, write ups etc.

IMAGES

- All images must be submitted as JPEGS
- 7063 (w) x 500 (h) pixels
- 300 dpi
- File size: 5MB - 50MB per JPEG
- Maximum: 10 JPEGS per entry
- Text in image must be legible when projected on screen
- Where necessary, submit close up images of small details

FILM

- File format: MOV / MP4
- 1280 (w) x 720 (h) or 1920 (w) x 1080 (h) pixels
- All video entries must be less than 400MB
- Entry / overview videos must not exceed 2mins
- All non-English entries must have English subtitles
- Entry links from Youtube and will be accepted

AUDIO

- File format: MP3
- All non-English entries must be submitted with accompanying English subtitle script
- Maximum file size: 100MB

- **LATE LAIF ENTRY:** 1st - 5th of November, 2024

MEDIA LAIF	Media LAIF category, should highlight innovative and strategic use of media channels that drive measurable impact. FILM CRAFT

To qualify for the Film Craft category at the LAIF awards, your work should demonstrate exceptional technical skill and artistry in any aspect of filmmaking. This includes but is not limited to cinematography, editing, sound design, visual effects, and production design. Your submission should showcase innovative techniques, creative problem-solving, and a mastery of your craft that elevates the overall quality and impact of the film.

FILM CRAFT CATEGORIES

Best Writing	To qualify for "Best Writing" in the Film Craft category at the LAIF awards, your work should demonstrate exceptional storytelling, character development, and dialogue. Your script should be original, engaging, and contribute significantly to the overall quality and impact of the film. The writing should be well-structured, with compelling characters, a strong narrative, and thought-provoking themes. Additionally, the dialogue should be natural, authentic, and serve to advance the story and reveal character motivations.
Best Use of Animation	To qualify for "Best Use of Animation" in the Film Craft category at the LAIF awards, your work should demonstrate innovative and effective use of animation techniques. This could include traditional animation, stop-motion animation, 2D, 3D, or a combination of these methods. The animation should enhance the storytelling, create visually stunning sequences, or convey complex ideas in a unique and engaging way. The overall impact of the animation should be significant, contributing to the overall quality and artistic value of the film.

Best use of short-form branded content video (Skits)	For an entry in the Best Short-Form Branded Content Video in the Digital and Mobile Craft category at the LAIF Awards, the advertising work should demonstrate exceptional creativity and effectiveness in delivering a brand message through concise, engaging video content. The submission should highlight how the short-form video—whether a branded skit, ad, or quick series—captivates viewers with its originality, clear messaging, and high production quality within a limited timeframe. It should excel in capturing attention quickly, delivering a memorable and impactful brand experience, and encouraging interaction or sharing. The work should effectively utilize the short-form format to drive engagement and create a strong connection with the audience, showcasing innovative approaches and achieving measurable results.

The mixing and mastering should be balanced, clear, and engaging, with a professional and polished sound. The audio engineering should reflect a deep understanding of audio broadcasting standards and optimized for its desired listening environment. The production mixing and mastering should contribute significantly to the overall quality and impact of the audio piece, enhancing the listener's experience and ensuring a professional and enjoyable listening experience.

For an entry in the Print Craft category at the LAIF Awards, the advertising work should demonstrate exceptional creativity and craftsmanship in the creation of print ads. This includes mastery in layout, typography, imagery, and design to effectively convey a brand's message or tell a compelling story. The ad should not only grab attention but also evoke emotion, resonate with its audience, and showcase the strategic use of print media. Every visual and textual element should work harmoniously to enhance the overall impact of the message, highlighting both the aesthetic and communicative strength of the print medium.

PRINT CRAFT CATEGORIES

Best Use of Photo Manipulation	For an entry in the Best Use of Photo Manipulation in the Print Craft category at the LAIF Awards, the advertising work should showcase exceptional skill in transforming imagery to create a powerful and visually striking print ad. It should display a high level of artistic skill, creativity, and originality, with attention to detail that complements the overall design. The use of illustration should elevate the ad's impact, making it memorable and engaging for the audience.
Best Use of Copy	For an entry in the Best Use of Copy in the Print Craft category at the LAIF Awards, the advertising work should demonstrate exceptional skill in the use of language to convey a compelling and persuasive message. The copy should be creative, concise, and perfectly tailored to the ad's target audience, adding depth and meaning to the visual elements. It should enhance the narrative, evoke emotions, and leave a lasting impression through clever wordplay, impactful storytelling, or a memorable tagline. They should capture the essence of the brand or message through unique perspectives, compelling compositions, and emotive visual storytelling. The use of photography should be integral to the concept, demonstrating creativity and skill in capturing moments that resonate with the audience and enhance the overall effectiveness of the ad.

JUDGING THE LAIF AWARDS 2024

JUDGING CRITERIA

For the **LAIF Awards**, the judging criteria focuses on key elements that reflect creativity across various categories. While the specific emphasis may vary slightly based on the category, the overall criteria are as follows:

1. Idea (40%)

- **Conceptualisation:** The brilliance, strength and clarity of the central idea behind the work.
- **Originality:** The uniqueness and creativity of the concept.
- **Resolution:** How well the idea addresses a specific challenge or opportunity.

2. Execution (20%)

- **Craftsmanship:** The quality of the finishing of the work.
- **Articulation:** Excellence in how the work conveys the message.
- **Integration:** How effectively the work is executed in its chosen medium.

3. Impact (20%)

- **Effectiveness:** The results and impact on the brand, business, or social outcome.
- **Engagement:** The work's ability to captivate and resonate with the target audience.
- **Reach:** The extent to which the work successfully connected with its intended audience.

4. Relevance (10%)

- **Brand Alignment:** How well the idea fits with the brand's message and objectives.
- **Cultural Context:** How the work taps into relevant cultural or market-specific insights.

5. Inspiring (10%)

- **Raise the bar:** How well does the work raise the standards of the business, sector, society
- **Raise the game:** How well does the work raise the standards of the creative practice and industry

These criteria ensures that the **LAIF Awards** recognize creativity, however LAIF Awards will always rely on the judges keen discernment in judging work.

JUDGING PROCESS

Each year, members of the Jury are chosen by the Jury Committee of the LAIF Management Board. The criteria includes but is not limited to pedigree in the industry, past performance, Excellence in related fields, inclusivity etc. A Jury President is also appointed for each of the LAIF categories. Each member of the LAIF Jury will get their Jury code with which to gain access to the jury only segment of the LAIF.com.ng portal. Judging period is within 1 week of closing entries.

1. MAIN / CRAFT CATEGORY

- The Point system outlined in the judging criteria segment applies here
- Place your vote by ticking/checking the necessary space
- A work would have won if it has gathered the highest number of votes

3. SPECIAL AWARDS

- At the end of voting, all Jury Presidents will nominate from their category not more than 3 works that are eligible for Grand Prix
- Each Jury President will then cast one vote in support of one work they feel best captures the objectives outlined in the description
- Jury Presidents must abstain from voting in their category
- Where any Jury President feels no work meets the necessary criteria for winning, they can abstain from voting
- The winning work must poll more than half of the Jury votes
- Where no work polls more than half in a particular category, no winner will emerge or be announced for that category
- HER, Innovation, GOOD will be judged based on the objectives of their entry criteria by the jury presidents

JUDGING DO'S & DON'TS

For the **LAIF Awards**, the judging criteria focuses on key elements that reflect creativity across various categories. While the specific emphasis may vary slightly based on the category, the overall criteria are as follows:

- Judges are NOT to reach out to any agency to discuss their role during or after judging
- Judges are not to disclose how they voted
- Judges are not to coerce/lobby other judges to vote for a work or agency
- Please abstain if the work is from your agency/network or if you contributed in anyway to its Conceptualisation/Production
- Judge the work only based on the category/industry/craft it was entered for, please refrain from re-allocating work to another category/Industry/craft
- Where you feel work has been entered into the wrong category/Industry/craft please Jury Presidents are to kindly notify the LAIF Jury Management Committee
- Please kindly refrain from coercion/lobbying for votes and report and fellow Judge indulging in such practice
